

How to change a clutch on a KSB5 Blender

Please note: Replacement of the clutch Part 92420 is not covered under warranty

The simplest way to remove your existing damaged clutch is with a large flat head screwdriver and a tea towel.

Step (1) Place the tea towel over the base of the blender to prevent the paint chipping when changing the clutch.

Step (2) Insert the tip of the screwdriver under the aluminum side of the rubber clutch



Step (3) Gently work the screwdriver from side to side lifting up at the same time. (You may have to alternate sides)

Step (4) This will gradually break the thread on the damaged clutch.

Step (5) Place new clutch on thread and screw on until (thumb tight) this will tighten and lock after the first use.
